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Multi-Family Reference Matrix Dwelling Unit Kitchens

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This reference lists the different items typically found in dwelling unit kitchens or required by kitchen design for mobility, accessible, adaptible or usable kitchens. The matrix compares, on an element-by-element basis, requirements for the 2010 ADA Standards, UFAS, FHA Design Manual, 2013 CBC-11B, 2013 CBC-11A, and 2010 CBC-11A along with the sourcing for each. By knowing which regulations pertain to your project, this matrix allows you to quickly compare and ascertain which are the controlling requirements and features per each item.

CLEAR FLOOR SPACE AT OVENS, DISHWASHERS, REFRIGERATORS, THE 30-inch x 48-inch clear floor space oriented in either one of two positions—parallel or perpendicular— is required at the oven, dishwasher, refrigerator, freezer, and trash compactor. Wall mounted and microwave ovens, like ovens in ranges, also must have either a parallel or perpendicular clear floor space adjacent to the appliance. Even though this group of appliances has operable doors that require the user to be able to get out of the way of the door swing, for purposes of design and room layout the clear floor space must be centered on the appliance itself. In addition to the turning space, the kitchen must be arranged so there is a 30-inch x 48- inch clear floor space for a parallel approach centered on the sink, range, or cooktop.
